
In 2023, new Goncharenko centres were opened in Kyiv, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Rohan and Odesa

# HELP FOR THE ARMY

In 2023, the Goncharenko centres team across the country raised more than UAH **5,500,000** to help the Armed Forces of Ukraine





### HELP FOR THE ARMY

For these funds, we have purchased more than 20 vehicles, dozens of drones of various types (surveillance, reconnaissance and FPV drones), dozens of Starlinks, more than 10 anti-drone rifles, contracted a Chaklun UAV for the Special Forces, and equipped a command and control vehicle for the Kyiv Sich battalion.






### HELP FOR THE ARMY

The Goncharenko Centre Online has also launched free specialised English courses for military personnel. About 1,000 soldiers of the Defence Forces are already taking courses with our teachers.



More than **25,000** events at the Goncharenko Centre include not only English and Ukrainian language courses, but also Polish, German, Italian, French and even Chinese courses from qualified teachers.

In addition, in 2023, we launched separate English courses for the elderly (60+) and began preparing schoolchildren for the National Multi-subject Test (NMT) in various subjects free of charge, and implemented a number of workshops and educational projects.

At the end of 2023, the Goncharenko Centres network launched free Driving theory courses for Ukrainians. In the first week alone, we received more than 3,000 applications from future drivers from all over Ukraine.

The training has already started on the Online platform, as well as in the cities of Balta, Kropyvnytskyi, Netishyn, Dergachy, Kodyma, Kyiv, Cherkasy, Dnipro and Odesa. Our plans for 2024 are to launch a driving school in all our centres.



### English course with the University of Pennsylvania

In May 2023 our team, together with the University of Pennsylvania, launched a special English course – English for career development.

In two weeks, we received an incredible number of applications from people from all over Ukraine – over 2000 – and selected 400 of the most motivated and ambitious students.

Our students studied for 5 weeks under the mentorship of Ivy League professors to present themselves in the international labour market and take their first steps to develop their careers.

### English for Career Development











Together with partners from the DrukArmy volunteer movement, we have launched a network of free 3D printing workshops in Kyiv, Odesa, Dnipro, Kharkiv and Dobrovelychkivka in Kirovohrad oblast.

In January, printing printing workshops will open in the Goncharenko centres in Ivano-Frankivsk, Kropyvnytskyi, Cherkasy, Zhytomyr, Kryvyi Rih, Rivne, Khmelnytskyi, Mykolaiv and Chernivtsi.

# **OTHER PROJECTS**

In September, the network of Goncharenko Centres launched the all-Ukrainian project to support women from military families, Plus-Plus. We provide wives, sisters and mothers of defenders with free legal aid and psychological support, as well as help with the implementation of their own projects.

In three months, more than 2,000 women from all over Ukraine registered to participate in the project. Today, Plus-Plus operates in all Goncharenko centres and on our online platform.





### **OTHER PROJECTS**

Together with the Konrad Adenauer Foundation, we held the first LEAD:UA Political School for Youth, bringing together 30 best students from across the country.

MPs, officials, diplomats, political strategists, and journalists came together at the Goncharenko Centre Kyiv to share their knowledge with students and explain how politics really works. The most active participants of the project were invited to take part in an internship at the Goncharenko Centres network.
